



SNOWFLAKE COMPUTING

ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

Dated: July 2017

This Acceptable Use Policy (the "Policy") sets forth the restrictions regarding customer's use of the Snowflake Services under the Master SaaS Agreement or the Terms of Service or other similar online terms ("the Agreement") between Snowflake and Customer.

Customer shall not:

- (a) use the Services to store or transmit infringing, libelous, or otherwise unlawful or tortious material, or to store or transmit material in violation of third-party privacy rights;;
- (b) use the Services to store or transmit viruses or malicious code;;
- (c) interfere with or disrupt the integrity or performance of any Services;;
- (d) attempt to gain unauthorized access to any Services or any related systems or networks;;
- (e) permit direct or indirect access to or use of the Services in a way that violates the Agreement, or use any of the Services to access or use any Snowflake Technology except as permitted under the Agreement, an Order Form, or the Documentation;;
- (f) copy the Services or any part, feature, function or user interface thereof.
